- Registrations are for blocks of 2 weeks (it is possible to register for several blocks):

 - **July 21 to August 1st**
 - **August 4 to August 15**
 - **August 18 to 22.**
- **HOURS: 9am to 4pm, Monday to Friday.**
- Registration fee: **\$600 per two-weeks block. \$300 for the last week.**
- All **materials** and **apron** are included.
- Participants must bring **their own lunches (nuts free).**
- **VERNISSAGE** on Fridays July 18, August 1st, August 15 and August 22 with family and friends, starting at 3pm.
- **REGISTRATION DATE: April 22nd to May 19, 2025 via the form online.**
- **Participant eligibility criteria:** Mild to moderate neurodevelopmental disorders. Participants must be autonomous in terms of eating, toileting, etc.
- **Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.** The Creative Arts Program reserves the right to refuse any application that does not meet the eligibility criteria. Once we have received your completed form, our team will meet with you to form groups and complete registration. Groups of maximum 12 people.
